- Maintain equipment regularly and ensure it complies with applicable road safety regulations to prevent spills of liquids, lubricants, and fuels in company yards, as well as emissions exceeding permitted limits. Vehicles parked in the company yards must switch off their engines.

In line with our sustainability values, Tiesse S.p.A. recommends, where applicable, the following environmental best practices:


- Plan regulatory and environmental compliance activities at least annually;

 - Internal and external noise
 - Special waste
 - Use of chemicals harmful to humans and the environment

 - Discharge of wastewater
 - Packaging used for goods transport
 - Induced vehicular traffic
- Identify potential environmental disturbances caused by activities to eliminate their causes;
- Adopt technologically advanced equipment and systems to contain/reduce environmental impacts;
- Pursue continuous improvement in preventing and limiting the environmental impacts of project activities:
- Promote awareness and environmental responsibility among employees through training and information initiatives:
- Integrate principles of environmental, social, and economic sustainability into decision-making and operational processes.




